Chicken Pox

Just to keep you informed; we have had a reported case of Chicken Pox in our younger years so please be extra vigilant and keep an eye on your children (for example for raised temperatures or red spots). The contagious period is before signs or symptoms appear but we would suggest you let us know from home if you suspect anything. Class Teachers are also keeping an extra eye.
