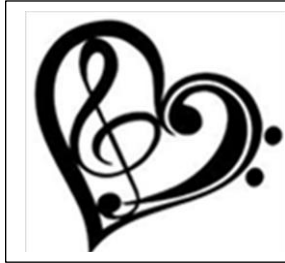
## Parent Teacher Conferences
