There is a huge amount of speculation in the media regarding the circumstances of Sylvester's passing but a message that was clear to all in the education sector, was that we have a duty to reiterate regularly to all staff and children the importance of understanding the term "safeguarding". Our Designated Safeguarding Lead at NISL is juf Claske. On Monday 6th at 1.30pm, all Primary staff and students observed a minute's silence in honour of Sylvester and for his family. Children have been addressed about speaking up for themselves if ever they feel threatened by adult or child. They have also been reminded of the importance to seek counsel in, or share information with, an adult if they feel a friend is being maltreated, undervalued or abused.
