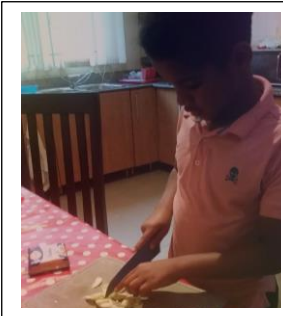
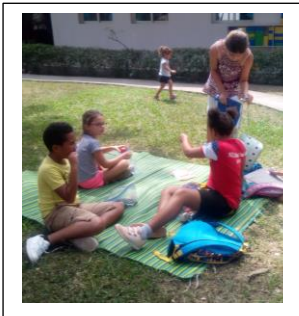
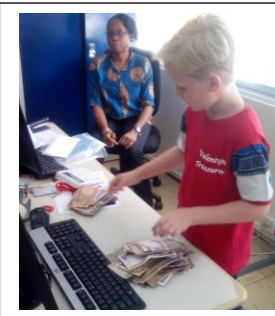
Birthday Reminders

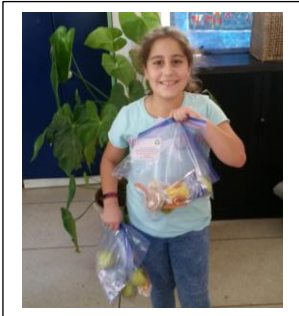
- Party packs/juice/personal photographers are not permitted
